A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to highways and transportation; including
2 alternative fuels in a fuel tax exemption; and providing
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-18-201(s) and (t) is amended to
8 read:

10 **31-18-201. Commercial vehicles; registration;**
11 **exemptions.**

13 (s) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
14 owners of commercial vehicles meeting the registration
15 requirements of another jurisdiction and subject to
16 registration in Wyoming and not entitled to exemption from

1 registration or licensing under this section may, as an
2 alternative to registration or proportional registration
3 secure a temporary permit from the department to make a
4 single trip into, within or out of Wyoming for a period of
5 not to exceed ninety-six (96) hours for a fee of twenty
6 dollars (\$20.00) for each single unit operated as a single
7 unit or forty dollars (\$40.00) for each legal combination
8 of units including only one (1) power unit. In lieu of the
9 fee required by W.S. 39-17-106(g), ~~or~~ 39-17-206(d) ~~or~~
10 39-17-306(f) for license and taxation of gasoline, ~~or~~
11 diesel or alternative fuels, the operator may secure a
12 temporary permit from the department to operate in Wyoming
13 for a period of not to exceed ninety-six (96) hours for a
14 fee of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) for each
15 single unit operated as a single unit or fifteen dollars
16 (\$15.00) for each legal combination of units including only
17 one (1) power unit.

19 (t) An owner of a commercial vehicle engaged in the
20 motion picture industry whose vehicle is properly
21 registered in another state and not entitled to the
22 registration or licensing exemption under W.S. 31-2-224 or
23 this section may, as an alternative to registration or

1 proportional registration and in lieu of the fee required
2 by W.S. 39-17-106(g), ~~and~~ 39-17-206(d) or 39-17-306(f),
3 apply to the department for a temporary permit to operate
4 the vehicle in Wyoming for ninety (90) days upon payment of
5 the appropriate fees prescribed in subsection (s) of this
6 section. As used in this subsection, "motion picture
7 industry" includes all filming in this state for commercial
8 purposes including advertising. Any person operating a
9 vehicle in Wyoming beyond the period authorized in the
10 temporary permit is subject to a civil penalty requiring
11 full registration of the vehicle in Wyoming for the
12 registration year in which the violation occurred and
13 payment of all fees required for registration.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
