Catch Title: Military training memorials.

Subject: Authorizing memorials to be erected to commemorate deaths from military

training exercises.

Summary/Major Elements:

• This act authorizes the creation of memorials to commemorate military members who died in accidents during training exercises in Wyoming during United States involvement in overseas wars and conflicts. The memorials shall specifically honor the known crash sites located at Shirley Basin, Edgerton and Bomber Peak.

- The Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources, in cooperation with the Wyoming Military Department and appropriate nongovernmental organizations, may design and create the memorials. The Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources shall consult with the Wyoming Department of Transportation to identify the placement of the memorials in appropriate locations accessible to the public along public roads, highways or parking areas.
- The act authorizes using private funds or funds from other non-state entities for the memorials and prohibits the expenditure of state funds.
