**Catch Title:** **Public utility assessment.**

**Subject:** Funding for the Public Service Commission.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- Current law provides that the Public Service Commission is funded through the collection of an assessment applied to the gross Wyoming intrastate retail revenues of public utilities. The assessment is calculated to provide funding for the Public Service Commission's legislatively-approved budget and cannot exceed three-thousandths (.003) of the gross Wyoming intrastate retail revenue.
- This act allows the State to collect an additional utility assessment, not to exceed two-thousandths (.002) of the gross intrastate Wyoming retail revenues of certain types of public utilities, to fund the Public Service Commission.
