Catch Title: State parks account-expenditure authority.

**Subject:** Expenditure authority for Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources.

## **Summary/Major Elements:**

• Under current law, fees for permits to use state parks, recreational areas, archeological sites and historic sites are deposited to an account in the special revenue fund. The use of funds in this account is limited by law. This act increases the expenditure authority of the Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources over the state parks account for fiscal years 2022 and 2023.

- Permits the Department, with legislative approval, to expend up to sixty percent (60%)—an increase from thirty percent (30%) in current law—of the funds in the account for maintenance and operational costs associated with outdoor recreation areas and facilities.
- As in current law, no funds may be used for additional full-time employees, for increases in salaries or for overtime pay for full-time employees.
