**Catch Title:** **Voter identification.**

**Subject:** Requires voters to present acceptable identification before in-person voting.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This act requires voters to present a form of acceptable identification before in-person voting at a polling place or absentee polling place.
- Forms of acceptable identification include valid forms of photo identification issued by a state, tribal or federal government, a Wyoming higher educational institution or public school, and Medicare and Medicaid insurance cards.
- Voters who do not present acceptable identification may cast provisional ballots.
- Further, this act requires the Department of Transportation to waive the fee on identification cards if the card is to be used only for the purpose of voter identification.
