Catch Title: Alcoholic beverage permits.

Subject: Permits governing the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act creates a twenty-four (24) hour permit for winery permit holders to sell their manufactured wine off the premises of the winery at certain events. The wine may not be sold or consumed off the premises described in the permit.
- Permittees are limited to twelve twenty-four hour permits per calendar year. The act authorizes a local licensing authority to impose a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) to fifty dollars (\$50.00) per permit.
- The act also provides that microbrewery and winery permit holders may hold a manufacturer's license.
