Subject: Amending the permissible district courts where judicial review of agency

actions may be sought.

Summary/Major Elements:

 Current law authorizes a person adversely affected or aggrieved by a final agency decision to seek judicial review in certain district courts, including the district court in the county in which the agency action (or inaction) was taken, the district court in the county in which real property is affected, or the district court in the county where the person resides or has his principal place of business.

- This act provides that a person may also seek judicial review of an agency action in the district court in the county where the injury or harm for which relief is sought occurred.
- The act applies to petitions for judicial review filed on or after July 1, 2021.
