Catch Title: **COVID-19 business relief programs agriculture.**
Subject: Agriculture businesses COVID-19 relief grants.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill authorizes appropriations to the Business Council to provide grants to agriculture businesses.
- The bill creates a definition of "agriculture business."
- The bill appropriates an amount to be determined by the legislature from remaining federal CARES Act funds to be used for grants.
- The bill provides that funds shall be distributed to livestock producers based on the number of livestock owned or acres of crops produced and must take into account the relative value of the livestock or crops.
- The bill specifies that producers shall provide necessary information to substantiate any COVID-19 related loss and that producers shall be subject to any necessary audits to ensure compliance with program requirements.
