Catch Title: **Slayer rule-amendments.**
Subject: Provides that the taking of the life of another precludes any rights of survivorship or payable on death benefits.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act provides that no person who feloniously kills a person with whom he or she holds property in a joint tenancy or any other form of co-ownership with a right of survivorship shall inherit, receive or otherwise take any of the property jointly held with the decedent.
- Further, the act provides that this "slayer rule" is applicable to payable on death or similar benefits and serving in a fiduciary or representative capacity upon a decedent's death.
- The act provides that the killer is deemed to have predeceased other beneficiaries or heirs when distributing assets under a will, trust or other dispositive instrument.
