Catch Title: Transportation statutory amendments-2.

Subject: Includes alternative fuels in a fuel tax exemption that already includes gasoline

and diesel fuels.

Summary/Major Elements:

• Under current law, operators of commercial vehicles that meet certain requirements may purchase a temporary permit from the Department of Transportation to operate in Wyoming for up to a ninety-six (96) hour period as an alternative to registration or proportional registration and in lieu of purchasing an International Fuel Tax Agreement license and decal. Also under current law, operators of commercial vehicles involved in the motion picture industry that meet certain requirements may purchase a temporary permit from the Department of Transportation to operate in Wyoming for up to ninety (90) days as an alternative to registration or proportional registration and in lieu of purchasing an International Fuel Tax Agreement license and decal.

• The International Fuel Tax Agreement license and decal applies for gasoline and diesel fuel pursuant to W.S. 39-17-106(g) and 39-17-206(d). It also applies for alternative fuels under W.S. 39-17-306(f). This act adds alternative fuel vehicles to the list of vehicles that are allowed to secure a temporary permit from the Department of Transportation instead of purchasing the International Fuel Tax Agreement license and decal.
