Catch Title: Board of dental examiners-amendments.
Subject: Amending examination, fee, and license requirements for the practice of dentistry and dental hygienists.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act amends various provisions of Wyoming law regulating the practice of dentistry and licensure of dentists in Wyoming.
- The act strikes references to specific testing requirements for dental license applicants and dental-hygienist applicants; instead, applicants must pass a written, clinical and state examination that follows national standards as the Board of Dental Examiners requires by rule.
- The act strikes a mandatory requirement for the Board to assess examination fees and grants discretion to the Board to charge examination fees.
- The act amends various administrative requirements for the Board, including recordkeeping and mailing requirements associated with applicants and informing applicants of test results.
- License renewal requirements are amended in the act to require renewal every other year and clarifies when a license expires for failure to renew.
