**Catch Title:** **Limiting firearm seizure and regulation during emergencies.**  
**Subject:** Limits on powers concerning regulating firearms during states of emergency.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- Current law limits the power of the executive branch to impose additional firearm-related restrictions during states of emergency that the governor declares.
- This act amends those limitations to specify that Wyoming law concerning states of emergency do not allow the executive branch to impose the following limitations during states of emergency:
  - Close or limit the operating hours of any person selling firearms or ammunition unless the closures or limitations apply equally to all forms of commerce in the state or political subdivision;
  - Close or limit the hours of any shooting range;
  - Place restrictions or quantity limitations on the lawful sale of weapons, ammunition and weapon components;
  - Suspend or revoke a permit to carry a concealed weapon unless the suspension or revocation is otherwise authorized by law.
- The act clarifies that the executive branch cannot impose additional restrictions as to the permitting of weapons and includes "personal weapons" as a category for which additional restrictions cannot be imposed.
