Employment support fund established. 11 (a) There is established the employment support fund. 12 13 Revenues allocated pursuant to W.S. 27-3-505(a) shall be 14 credited to the employment support fund by the department, 15 with receipt and acknowledgement submitted to the state 16 treasurer. The state treasurer shall invest available

1	revenues in the fund in accordance with law, and earnings
2	from those investments shall be credited to the fund.
3	Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008 and 9-4-207, the monies in
4	the employment support fund shall not revert. to the
5	general fund at the end of any fiscal year, except that any
б	unappropriated amounts remaining in the fund at the end of
7	any fiscal year shall be transferred by the state treasurer
8	to the state unemployment insurance trust fund created
9	pursuant to W.S. 27-3-209.
10	
11	(c) The department shall report annually to the joint
12	appropriations committee and the joint labor, health and
13	social services interim committee not later than September
14	1 of each year on the status of the employment support
15	fund, detailing fund expenditures and the fund's current
16	balance.
17	

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
