A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state elected officials' salaries;  
2 increasing the salaries for state elected officials  
3 following the 2022 general election; providing for current  
4 salaries; providing appropriations; and providing for an  
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-101(a)(i) through (v) is amended  
10 to read:

11

12 **9-3-101. Salaries; amount; date of payment.**

13

14 (a) Salaries for clerk of the supreme court and  
15 district court reporters shall be determined by the supreme

1 court as authorized by legislative appropriations. Subject  
2 to constitutional limitations the following state officers  
3 and members of the judiciary shall receive the salaries  
4 indicated by the figures following their respective titles:

6 (i) Governor ~~\$105,000.00~~ \$140,000.00;

8 (ii) Secretary of state ~~\$92,000.00~~ \$125,000.00;

10 (iii) State auditor ~~\$92,000.00~~ \$125,000.00;

12 (iv) State treasurer ~~\$92,000.00~~ \$125,000.00;

14 (v) Superintendent of public instruction

15 ~~\$92,000.00~~ \$125,000.00.

17 **Section 2.**

19 (a) The amended salaries provided for in section 1 of  
20 this act shall begin upon the swearing into office of the  
21 elected official following the 2022 general election. Until  
22 that time the following annual salary schedule shall apply:

12       **Section 3.**

14       (a) There is appropriated the following amounts from  
15 the general fund to the specified entities to provide the  
16 salary increases to the state elected officials provided by  
17 section 1 of this act for the period beginning January 1,  
18 2023 and ending June 30, 2024:

20               (i) Governor's office, sixty-five thousand  
21 dollars (\$65,000.00);

1                   (ii) Secretary of state's office, sixty-one  
2 thousand dollars (\$61,000.00);

4                   (iii) State treasurer's office, sixty-one  
5 thousand dollars (\$61,000.00);

6

7                   (iv) State auditor's office, sixty-one thousand  
8 dollars (\$61,000.00);

9

10                   (v) Wyoming department of education, sixty-one  
11 thousand dollars (\$61,000.00).

13                   **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2022.
