AN ACT relating to state funded capital construction; modifying 1 2 accounts; directing the deposit of rental income as specified; providing definitions; providing appropriations for purposes 3 4 related to state funded capital construction; making certain 5 appropriations subject to specified terms and conditions; providing matching funds for specified projects; authorizing the 6 land and appurtenant buildings as 7 purchase of specified;

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 9-2-3204(h) by creating a new paragraph

13 (iv), 9-4-225 and 9-5-109(j) are amended to read:

1 (h) The general services division shall:

(iv) Account for separately any rental income generated under a lease agreement with a third party under paragraph (b)(xix) of this section for the occupancy of unused portions of any building used as the quarters for the state trails program field office for the support of the state trails program under W.S. 36-4-108(b)(iv). Any rental income as specified under this paragraph shall be deposited quarterly and in equal amounts into the snowmobile trails account created by W.S. 31-2-409(c) and the off-road recreational vehicle trails account created by W.S. 31-2-703(c).

# 14 9-4-225. Capitol square preservation account.

The capitol square preservation account is created. The state treasurer may accept federal grants and other contributions, grants, gifts, transfers, bequests and donations of money from any source for deposit into the account. Funds within the account shall only be expended upon legislative appropriation are continuously appropriated for maintenance, preservation and enhancement of the capitol building and grounds, the extension from the capitol building to and under the Herschler building and

- 2 only be expended consistent with this section and pursuant to the
- 3 terms of a memorandum of understanding executed pursuant to W.S.
- 4 9-5-106(f). All funds within the account shall be invested by

- 17 within the account shall not be transferred or expended for any

- 21 legislature. At the end of each fiscal year, any unexpended,

9	(b) Appropriations for projects in this act remain in
10	effect until the project is completed, unless otherwise provided.
11	The amounts appropriated for projects under this act shall be
12	expended only on the projects specified and any unexpended,
13	unobligated funds remaining upon completion of a project shall
14	revert to the accounts from which they were appropriated, unless
15	otherwise provided. The amounts appropriated in this act are
16	intended to provide a maximum amount for each project and shall
17	not be construed to be an entitlement or guaranteed amount.

19	(c) "This appropriation" when used in a footnote shall be
20	construed as a reference to that portion of the appropriated
21	funds identified in the footnote.

In consultation with the Wyoming parks and cultural resources commission and the Wyoming trails advisory council, the 13 department of state parks and cultural resources is authorized to 14 15 purchase lands and appurtenant buildings in the name of the state 16 of Wyoming to provide suitable quarters for the state trails 17 program field office for the support of the state trails program under W.S. 36-4-108(b)(iv) and of the department in carrying out 18 19 its powers and duties as prescribed by law. The purchase 20 authority provided to the department by this subsection is 21 contingent on certification by the state building commission that the subject lands and appurtenant buildings to be purchased have 22 been properly inspected and are in suitable condition. 23

2 There is appropriated one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000.00) from the snowmobile trails 3 account created by W.S. 31-2-409(c) and one million four hundred thousand 4 dollars (\$1,400,000.00) from the off-road recreational vehicle 5 6 trails account created by W.S. 31-2-703(c) to the department of state parks and cultural resources for the purpose of purchasing 7 8 land and appurtenant buildings in accordance with subsection (a) 9 of this section. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this 10 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this 11 appropriation shall revert in equal proportions to the snowmobile 12 trails account and the off-road recreational vehicle trails 13 14 account on June 30, 2023.
