1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; authorizing construction of designated water projects; describing 2 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for 3 4 projects; providing grants; providing appropriations; amending the sponsor's contingency fund; amending amounts 5 and terms of appropriations for specified prior projects; 6 transferring funds from water development account I to 7 8 water development account II; and providing for an 9 effective date.
