1	(c) Notwithstanding subsection (f) of this section,
2	the division may defer for successive five (5) year periods
3	the expiration of or renew the license of a licensee who is
4	on active duty in the armed forces of the United States <del>for</del>
5	successive five (5) year periods or of a licensee employed
6	by a federal, state or local government agency, where the
7	federal, state or local government agency requires the
8	licensee's physical presence in another state or foreign
9	<pre>country, upon terms and conditions as it the division may</pre>
10	prescribe. The division may similarly defer the expiration
11	of or renew the license of the spouse or dependent child of
12	the person in the armed forces or the federal, state or
13	local government agency if residing with that person.

15	Section 2. This act is effective September 1, 2022.
