A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; amending the crime  
2 of stalking to include a prohibition on using electronic  
3 devices to surveil another person as specified; and  
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-506(b)(iii), by creating a new  
9 paragraph (iv) and by renumbering (iv) as (v) is amended to  
10 read:

12 **6-2-506. Stalking; penalty.**

14 (b) Unless otherwise provided by law, a person  
15 commits the crime of stalking if, with intent to harass

1 another person, the person engages in a course of conduct  
2 reasonably likely to harass that person, including but not  
3 limited to any combination of the following:

5 (iii) Placing a person under surveillance by  
6 remaining present outside his or her school, place of  
7 employment, vehicle, other place occupied by the person, or  
8 residence other than the residence of the defendant; ~~or~~

10 (iv) Using any electronic, digital or global  
11 positioning system device or other electronic means to  
12 place another person under surveillance or to surveil  
13 another person's internet or wireless activity without  
14 authorization from the other person; or

16 ~~(iv)~~(v) Otherwise engaging in a course of  
17 conduct that harasses another person.

18

19 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2022.
