2 (a) This state and all political subdivisions of this 3 state are prohibited from using any personnel or funds 4 appropriated by the legislature of the state of Wyoming or any other source of funds that originated within the state 5 of Wyoming to enforce, administer or cooperate with any 6 unconstitutional act, law, treaty, executive order, rule or 7 regulation of the United States government that infringes 8 on or impedes the free exercise of individual rights 9 10 guaranteed under the Second Amendment to the Constitution 11 of the United States.

(b) Nothing in this act shall limit or restrict a public servant, as defined in W.S. 6-5-101(a)(vi), from providing assistance to federal authorities for purposes not specifically identified in subsection (a) of this section. Nothing in this act shall be construed to prohibit Wyoming governmental entities from accepting federal funds for law enforcement purposes.
