AN ACT relating to worker's compensation; amending the experience rating system requirements for claims related to COVID-19; repealing a fund transfer; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 27-14-201(u) is amended to read:

27-14-201. Rates and classifications; rate surcharge.

(u) No compensable injury related to COVID-19 that occurs during the period beginning January 1, 2020 and ending March 31, 2022 for which coverage is provided under this act and for which a claim was filed on or before ~~December 30, 2020~~ March 31, 2023 shall be chargeable to an employer's experience rating under this section. ~~The division shall estimate the cost to the fund of an injury subject to this subsection and shall deposit into the fund or dedicate within the fund the amount of the estimated cost but only to the extent federal monies are available for that purpose from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act, P.L. 116-136, or from any other available federal monies related to the COVID-19 emergency response.~~
