

**FISCAL NOTE**

The fiscal impact in the form of revenue and expenditure increases is indeterminable.

This bill authorizes the Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources (Department) to lease state lands for recreational purposes. The Department is also authorized to promulgate rules to collect fees which will be determined based upon the recreation value of the specified area, resulting in an indeterminable revenue increase. The Department also anticipates an expenditure increase in the form of lease payments as well as infrastructure, construction, operation, and maintenance of a recreational area. The lease payments will provide an associated revenue increase to the Office of State Lands and Investments. No land or lease has been agreed to, so it is unknown what revenue and expenditures will be incurred.
