Details of appropriation:

This bill appropriates \$300,000 from the School Foundation Program Account within section 3 to provide payments to school districts for expenditures related to professional development in the areas of evidence-based literacy instruction and intervention required under W.S. 21-3-401(e) created by this bill. School districts would be eligible to receive payments from the Department of Education for expenditures in excess of the amount provided within the K-12 education resource block grant model (funding model) for professional development.

Assumptions:

If total school year 2022-2023 district expenditures in excess of the funding model's professional development amount exceed the \$300,000 appropriation, the amount provided to each eligible school district will be prorated.
