Criminal record dissemination-military department.

FISCAL NOTE

No significant fiscal or personnel impact.

This bill would allow criminal record information to be disseminated to the Wyoming Military Department for military members serving on active duty or in the Wyoming National Guard for training, deployment, mobilization and security clearance purposes. These Wyoming Military Department requests would be accomplished based on knowledge of criminal investigations involving Wyoming National Guard members by the various law enforcement agencies around the state.

Historically this would involve a total of less than 12 requests annually to the various law enforcement entities. All actions on the part of the Wyoming Military Department will be conducted with existing resources for approximately 12 requests for information per year. This bill would now provide statutory authority to various law enforcement agencies around the state to release the criminal history information to the Wyoming Military Department.

On its own, this bill will not result in a significant revenue increase from fees or require additional personnel and/or funding. However, passage of multiple bills of this type may result in a cumulative administrative impact to the Division of Criminal Investigation.
