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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-3-116 is created to read:

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10 41-3-116. Permit for watering livestock on federal

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11 land.

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13 (a) As used in this section:

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1 (i) "Allotment" means a designated area of

2 federal land available for livestock grazing;

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4 (ii) "Animal unit month" or "AUM" means the

5 amount of forage needed to sustain one (1) cow and her

6 calf, one (1) horse or five (5) sheep or goats for one (1)

7 month;

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9 (iii) "Federal agency" means the United States,

10 the President of the United States and any department,

11 corporation, agency or instrumentality heretofore or

12 hereafter created, designated or established by the United

13 States;

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15 (iv) "Grazing permit" means a permit, lease or

16 other document authorizing livestock to graze on an

17 allotment;

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19 (v) "Livestock" means as defined by W.S.

20 11-22-101(a)(ii) but does not include wild horses claimed

21 by the federal government under the federal Wild

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22 Free-Roaming Horses and Burros Act, P.L. 92-195.

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- 1 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title
- 2 regarding permits to appropriate water, any permit issued
- 3 for the purposes of watering livestock on an allotment
- 4 shall:

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- 6 (i) Only be issued in the name of a federal
- 7 agency jointly with a person or grazing association who has
- 8 the right to use a grazing permit;

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- 10 (ii) Be appurtenant to the allotment or land on
- 11 which the livestock is watered;

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- 13 (iii) Not be changed under W.S. 41-3-104 or
- 14 amended under W.S. 41-4-514 without the consent of the
- 15 holder or holders of a valid grazing permit to graze
- 16 livestock on the allotment.

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- 18 (c) Any permit issued jointly in the name of a
- 19 federal agency and a grazing permit holder under this
- 20 section may be transferred to a different person or grazing
- 21 association that receives an allotment or grazing permit on
- 22 that federal land by filing for a name change with the

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23 state engineer's office.

1 2 (d) Notwithstanding W.S. 41-3-401, no appropriation 3 for the purpose of livestock watering on an allotment is 4 subject to abandonment or partial abandonment if: 5 (i) The nonuse is caused by, in whole or in 6 7 part, a federal agency's reduction of the AUMs on the 8 allotment; or 9 10 (ii) The nonuse is voluntary because a grazing 11 permit holder chooses not to graze livestock on that 12 allotment, provided that the nonuse shall not exceed five 13 (5) years. 14 (e) Nothing in this section 15 shall affect 16 livestock water right or permit held by a federal agency on 17 or before July 1, 2022. 18 19 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2022. 20
