1 AN ACT relating to the Eastern Shoshone and Northern 2 Arapaho Tribes; clarifying that the Eastern Shoshone and

3 Northern Arapaho Tribes may participate in specified

4 economic development programs; omitting separate

5 cooperative agreements for participation; specifying the

6 definition and rule of construction for the cooperative

7 tribal governing body; making conforming amendments; and

8 providing for an effective date.

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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12 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-1-103(a) by creating a new

13 paragraph (x), 9-12-601(a) and (b), 9-12-602, 9-12-801(c),

14 (e)(ii) and (f), 9-12-803(e), 9-12-804, 9-12-902(a),

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15 9-12-903(a) and 9-12-905(a) are amended to read:

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1 8-1-103. Rules of construction for statutes. 2 (a) The construction of all statutes of this state 3 4 shall be by the following rules, unless that construction 5 is plainly contrary to the intent of the legislature: 6 7 (x) Reference to the "cooperative tribal 8 governing body" means the inter-tribal council of the Eastern Shoshone and Northern Arapaho tribes or its 9 10 official successor joint governing body. If the cooperative tribal governing body is a party to a cooperative agreement 11 12 or contract with the state or a political subdivision under 13 the laws of this state, a successor joint tribal governing body shall remain a party to the agreement or contract 14 unless specified otherwise in the agreement or contract. 15 16 17 9-12-601. Wyoming business ready community program; purpose; creation; rulemaking. 18 19 20 (a) It is the purpose of this article to promote 21 economic development at the city, town and county level in

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order levels and on the Wind River Indian Reservation to

1 create additional economic health and a stronger state

2 economy.

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4 (b) The council shall establish and administer a Wyoming business ready community program as provided by 5 this article. Any city, town, or the Eastern 6 Shoshone or Northern Arapaho tribe, or the cooperative 7 8 tribal governing body, may submit an application to the 9 council for a grant or loan under the program on forms 10 prescribed by and subject to rules promulgated by the 11 council. Grants or loans may be applied for by a joint 12 powers board with the approval of all participating 13 agencies to the joint powers agreement. Grants and loans may be made by the council for economic or educational 14 15 development, planning or infrastructure projects, including 16 purchase of land, buildings, facilities, 17 telecommunications infrastructure, rights of way, airports, sewer and water projects, roads, landscaping, recreational 18 19 convention facilities or other infrastructure and 20 determined by the council to be consistent with the 21 purposes of this article. In adopting rules and making grants and loans under this article the council shall 22 23 require all projects to be related to economic

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- 1 educational development, planning or infrastructure, which
- 2 shall not include rehabilitation or expansion of existing
- 3 infrastructure unless the council determines the
- 4 rehabilitation or expansion is necessary to meet the
- 5 purposes of this article. Planning grants and loans shall
- 6 be limited as provided in subsection (m) of this section.
- 7 All grants, or loans or cooperative agreements made under
- 8 this article shall be referred by the council to the state
- 9 loan and investment board for final approval or
- 10 disapproval. The state loan and investment board may adopt
- 11 rules as necessary to implement its duties under this
- 12 article.

11 program on forms prescribed by and subject to rules

14 agencies to the joint powers agreement.

17 loans under this article, the council shall require all

18 projects to be related to economic development or

19 enhancement of quality of life in a community. Projects may

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22 (ii) The purchase of an interest in or

23 cooperative agreements for the expansion, renovation or

- 2 facilities exceed statewide school building and facility
- 3 adequacy standards established by the school facilities
- 4 commission under W.S. 21-15-115. No ownership interest to
- 5 the project or facility under a project shall remain with
- 6 the school district upon expenditure of any funds under
- 7 this program for any project.

- 10 recommended by the council shall be referred by the council
- 11 to the state loan and investment board for final approval

2 The community facilities program account is created within

3 the special revenue fund and shall consist of funds

4 credited to the account as provided by law. Funds in the

8 this article.

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10 9-12-902. Wyoming workforce housing infrastructure

11 program; creation; rulemaking.

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The council shall establish and administer a 13 (a) 14 workforce housing infrastructure program Wyoming 15 provided by this article. Any city, town, county, or 16 special improvement district or the Eastern Shoshone or 17 Northern Arapaho tribe, or the cooperative tribal governing body, may submit an application to the council for a loan 18 19 under the program on forms prescribed by and subject to 20 rules promulgated by the council. Loans may be applied for 21 by a joint powers board with the approval of all 22 participating agencies to the joint powers agreement. Loans 23 may be made by the council for workforce housing

1 infrastructure projects and community land trust projects.

2 In adopting rules and making loans under this article the

3 council shall require all projects to be related to

4 workforce housing infrastructure or community land trusts.

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6 9-12-903. Council duties; actions on loan

7 applications.

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9 (a) All complete applications to participate in the program established under this article, which conform with 10 11 the criteria established by law and rules promulgated under 12 this article and which are submitted to the council, shall 13 be considered by the council. The council shall approve or disapprove each application considered in accordance with 14 this article and rules promulgated by the council. All 15 16 loans or cooperative agreements made under this article 17 shall be referred by the council to the state loan and investment board for final approval or disapproval. 18 19 loan and investment board may adopt rules as
