The 2 division shall estimate the cost to the fund of an injury 3 subject to this subsection and shall deposit into the fund 4 or dedicate within the fund the amount of the estimated cost but only to the extent federal monies are available 5 for that purpose from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and 6 Economic Security (CARES) Act, P.L. 116-136, or from any 7 8 other available federal monies related to the COVID-19 9 emergency response. 10 Section 2.
