1 (a) A person operating a motorcycle shall ride only upon or astride the permanent and regular seat attached 2 3 thereto designed to be used by the driver, including a seat 4 that incorporates a wheelchair or other assistive device, and shall not carry any other person nor shall any other 5 person ride on a motorcycle unless the motorcycle is 6 designed to carry more than one (1) person, in which event 7 8 a passenger may ride upon or astride the permanent and 9 regular seat if designed for two (2) persons, or upon 10 another seat firmly attached to the motorcycle at the rear 11 or side of the operator.

(b) A person shall ride upon a motorcycle <u>only upon</u> or astride a seat designed to be used by the driver or, if the person is a passenger, a seat designed to be used by a passenger. If the seat is a saddle, a person shall only while sitting <u>sit</u> astride the <u>seat saddle</u>, facing forward, with one (1) leg on each side of the motorcycle.

20 (k) No person riding upon a motorcycle shall attach 21 himself or the motorcycle to any other moving vehicle on a 22 roadway. This does not prohibit:

5	(ii) Attaching a person, wheelchair or other

7	a motorcycle if the motorcycle is designed for the
