- 12 paragraph (xxxi) and 35-11-402(a)(xiii)(C) and by creating

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13 a new paragraph (xv) are amended to read:

Definitions. 2 3 (e) Specific definitions for land quality: 4 5 (xxxi) "Inert material" means any material that 6 is not reusable or recyclable, that will not undergo any significant physical, chemical or biological transformation 7 8 and that will not adversely affect other matter with which the material comes into contact. 9 10 11 35-11-402. Establishment of standards. 12 (a) The council shall, upon recommendation by the 13 advisory board through the administrator and the director, 14 15 establish rules and regulations pursuant to the following 16 reclamation standards for the affected areas, including but 17 not limited to: 18 19 (xiii) Rules and regulations governing the use 20 of decommissioned wind turbine blades and towers to 21 backfill surface coal mining sites as part of an approved

reclamation plan. Rules promulgated under this paragraph

shall, at a minimum, provide for:

(C) Disposal fees to be remitted to the department by the operator who allows disposal decommissioned wind turbine blades and towers in surface coal mining sites, which shall be twenty-five percent (25%) ten percent (10%) of any revenues collected by the operator for the disposal of the decommissioned wind turbine blades and towers. The fees collected under this subparagraph shall be credited to the general fund;

(xv) Rules and regulations governing the use of inert material to backfill non-coal mining sites as part of an approved reclamation plan. Rules promulgated under this paragraph shall, at a minimum, provide for:

(A) Minimum depth requirements for the burial of inert material to be buried below the surface and above any aquifers as defined in W.S. 35-11-103(h)(i). In setting depth requirements under this subparagraph, the council, administrator and director may consult standards for solid waste management facilities established by the solid and hazardous waste management division;

1	(B) The removal of all mechanical,
2	electrical and other materials from the inert material
3	allowing only the base inert material to be buried;
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5	(C) Disposal fees to be remitted to the
6	department by the operator who allows disposal of inert
7	material in non-coal mining sites, which shall be ten
8	percent (10%) of any revenues collected by the operator for
9	the disposal of the inert material. The fees collected
10	under this subparagraph shall be credited to the general
11	fund;
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13	(D) The incorporation or amendment of any
14	rules pertaining to solid and hazardous waste necessary to
15	allow for the disposal of inert material in non-coal mining
16	sites to be reclaimed.
