14 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of

15 this section, no person shall operate a passenger vehicle

1 in this state unless each child who is a passenger in that 2 vehicle and who has not reached his ninth birthday is properly secured in a child safety restraint system in a 3 4 seat of the vehicle other than the front seat, except if 5 the vehicle is only equipped with one (1) row of seats, or if all safety belts in the rows of seats behind the front 6 seat are in use by other child passengers in the vehicle, 7 8 the child may be properly secured in a child safety 9 restraint system in the front passenger seat of the 10 vehicle, except that a rear facing infant seat child safety 11 restraint system shall not be placed in front of an active 12 airbag. For each child who has not reached his second 13 birthday, the child safety restraint system required by this subsection shall be rear-facing. 14
