1 AN ACT relating to community college district elections;

2 amending the date of the first regular election of a

- 3 community college district board; providing for the terms
- 4 of members; clarifying provisions for the conduct of
- 5 community college district elections; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-18-302(a), 21-18-304(a)(x),
- 11 21-18-309, 21-18-312(r) and 22-22-102(a) and (c) are
- 12 amended to read:

14 21-18-302. District board generally; quorum;

15 organization; officers.

2 (a) Within thirty (30) days after the election 3 establishing the community college district and its initial 4 board, and on or about December 1 each year thereafter, the board shall meet and organize by electing one (1) of its 5 6 members as president, one (1) as treasurer, and one (1) as secretary. The president shall preside at all meetings of 7 the board except that a temporary chairman may be selected 8 9 by the board in his absence. The secretary shall keep the 10 minutes and proceedings of all board meetings and the treasurer shall receive all funds payable to the district 11 and disburse them on the order of the board. 12

16 (a) The community college district board shall:

18 (x) Conduct elections held by the community
19 college district for <u>the regular</u> election of board members,
20 the issuance of bonds, the questions of mill levies and

4 21-18-309. First regular election of board; fiscal 5 year.

The first regular election of a community college district 7 8 board following creation of a community college district 9 shall not be held until the May election date authorized 10 under W.S. 22-21-103 of the first fiscal year in which a 11 special mill tax is levied and assessed against the taxable property of the district for the uses and purposes of the 12 district date of the second succeeding general election 13 that follows the election establishing the community 14 college district and its initial board. The terms of the 15 16 members elected at the first regular election shall begin 17 as provided by W.S. 22-22-102(a) with the four (4) candidates receiving the highest number of votes serving 18 19 four (4) year terms and the candidates receiving the next 20 three (3) highest number of votes serving two (2) year 21 terms. The fiscal year of each community college district shall begin on July 1 of each year and shall end on June 30 22 23 of the following year.

4 (r) If the election for establishment carries, the 5 community college commission county clerk shall notify by 6 registered mail the seven (7) candidates who receive the highest number of votes in the entire election. The seven 7 8 (7) candidates shall constitute the initial board of the community college district. Terms of office shall begin on 9 10 the day immediately following the election and shall expire at 12:00 noon on the first day in December following the 11 first regular election of board members under W.S. 12 13 21-18-309.

15 **22-22-102.** Date of election of trustees; terms.

17 (a) The election of members of the board of trustees
18 of each school district and community college district
19 shall be held at the regular polling places for each
20 district on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in
21 November in general election years, except as otherwise
22 provided by law. Terms of office shall run for four (4)
23 years beginning at 12:00 noon on the first day in December

1	following the election, except as otherwise provided by
2	<u>law</u> .

4	(c) Not more than a simple majority of members of the
5	board of trustees of each school district and each
6	community college district shall be elected at any election
7	unless the election is to fill an unexpired term. This

9	board of a community college district or the first regular
