7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-2-116 through 28-2-119 are
- 10 repealed and recreated as 28-2-116 through 28-2-119 to
- 11 read:

13 28-2-116. Legislative districts generally;

16 (a) As used in W.S. 28-2-116 through 28-2-119:

1

2 (i) "Census block" means a geographic area of

3 the state of Wyoming specified by the United States bureau

4 of the census in accordance with the 2020 decennial census

5 and identified uniquely by census block number;

6

7 (ii) "Voter tabulation district" or "VTD" means

8 a geographic area of the state of Wyoming specified by the

9 United States bureau of the census in accordance with the

10 2020 decennial census and identified by Wyoming VTD name

11 and number;

12

13 (iii) "This act" means W.S. 28-2-116 through

14 28-2-119.

15

16 (b) As used in W.S. 28-2-118 and 28-2-119 unless the

17 context otherwise requires:

18

19 (i) "Blocks" designates the entire census block

20 as numbered by the United States bureau of the census for

21 the 2020 decennial census within the named VTD and county

2

22 is a part of the legislative district;

1 (ii) "(Name of) County" designates either that

2 the entire named Wyoming county is within the legislative

3 district or that a portion of the named Wyoming county as

4 specified is within the legislative district;

5

6 (iii) "District (number)" designates the

7 legislative district number assigned to a house or senate

8 legislative district from which a legislator is elected

9 under this act;

10

11 (iv) "VTD" designates either that the entire

12 voter tabulation district as named by the United States

13 bureau of the census for the 2020 decennial census within

14 the named county is a part of the legislative district or

15 that a portion of the named voter tabulation district

16 within the named county as specified is a part of the

17 legislative district.

18

19 (c) W.S. 28-2-118 creates legislative districts for

20 the Wyoming senate and W.S. 28-2-119 creates legislative

3

21 districts for the Wyoming house of representatives.

1 (d) The secretary of state shall maintain and make

2 available for public inspection in a hardcopy or electronic

3 format, or both, during regular business hours:

4

5 (i) The United States P.L. 94-171 data for the

6 2020 decennial census received by that office from the

7 United States bureau of the census; and

8

9 (ii) The list and geographic description of the

10 legislative districts for the Wyoming senate as provided in

11 W.S. 28-2-118(b) and enacted into law and the list and

12 geographic description of the legislative districts for the

13 Wyoming house of representatives as printed in "Attachment

14 A" referenced in W.S. 28-2-119(b) and enacted into law.

16 28-2-117. Effective date of changes in legislative

17 districts; election of holdover senators.

18

19 (a) Changes in all legislative districts are

20 effective for the 2022 general election cycle and the

21 sixty-seventh legislature.

1 Members for senate districts designated (b) as 2 even-numbered districts in W.S. 28-2-118(b) shall be 3 elected for a term of four (4) years at the 2022 general 4 election. Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, no election shall be held in 2022 for senate 5 districts designated as odd-numbered districts in W.S. 6 28-2-118(b) for which members were elected at the 2020 7 8 general election and nothing in this act shall affect the terms of those members. Members for senate districts 9 10 designated as odd-numbered districts in W.S. 28-2-118(b) shall be elected for a term of four (4) years at the 2024 11

general election.

(c) A member elected in the 2020 general election for a senate district designated as an odd-numbered district in W.S. 28-2-118(b) who has been removed from the district as a result of district boundary changes made by this act may continue to serve the remainder of the member's term for the district from which the member was elected.

21 (d) Nothing in this act otherwise affects the terms 22 of members of the sixty-sixth legislature.

2 nested house districts formed to create senate districts. 3 4 (a) Subsection (b) of this section creates legislative districts for the Wyoming senate consisting of 5 the numbered legislative districts contained therein. 6 There shall be one (1) senator elected from each 7 8 legislative district as specified in subsection (b) of this section. Senate districts shall consist of the entirety of 9 the geographic area of the two (2) house districts listed 10 in subsection (b) of this section for each senate district 11 12 and as fully described in "Attachment A." 13 14 (b) Senate districts shall consist of the entirety of 15 geographic area of the following two (2) the 16 districts per senate district: 17 Senate District 1 - House Districts 1 and 18 (i) 19 52; 20 (ii) Senate District 2 - House Districts 4 and 21 22 6;

2 representative elected from each legislative district as

3 specified in subsection (b) of this section. The area

4 within a county, voter tabulation district or census block

5 as provided in paragraphs (i) through (iii) of this

6 subsection is determined using the United States bureau of

7 the census topologically integrated geographic encoding and

8 referencing data base (TIGER®). Each numbered legislative

9 district in subsection (b) of this section consists of the

10 combined geographic area within the:

11

12 (i) Entire specified county, if the county alone

13 is listed with no geographic subdivision listed below it;

14

15 (ii) Voter tabulation district, if any are

16 listed below the specified county; and

17

18 (iii) Census block, if any are listed below the

19 specified voter tabulation district. A census block listed

20 below a voter tabulation district indicates a split voter

21 tabulation district.
