## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to abortions; prohibiting chemical abortion
- 2 drugs for abortions as specified; providing exceptions;
- 3 providing a criminal penalty for violating the prohibition
- 4 on use of chemical abortion drugs for abortions; providing
- 5 definitions; specifying exceptions; making conforming
- 6 amendments; and providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10 **Section 1**. W.S. 35-6-120 is created to read:

- 12 35-6-120. Chemical abortion drugs prohibited;
- 13 exceptions; penalty.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
- 2 person shall manufacture, distribute, prescribe, dispense,
- 3 sell, transfer or use any chemical abortion drug in the
- 4 state for the purpose of procuring or performing an
- 5 abortion.

- 7 (b) The prohibition in subsection (a) shall not apply
- 8 to:

9

- 10 (i) The sale, use, prescription or
- 11 administration of any contraceptive agent administered
- 12 before conception or before pregnancy can be confirmed
- 13 through conventional medical testing;

14

- 15 (ii) Treatment of a natural miscarriage
- 16 according to currently accepted medical guidelines;

- 18 (iii) Treatment necessary to protect the woman
- 19 from an imminent peril that substantially endangers her
- 20 life, according to appropriate medical judgment. "Imminent
- 21 peril" as used in this paragraph refers exclusively to a
- 22 physical, and not mental, condition. No medical treatment
- 23 may form the basis for an exception under this paragraph if

- 1 it is based on a claim or diagnosis that the pregnant woman
- 2 will engage in conduct which she intends to result in her
- 3 death or other self-harm.

4

- 5 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any
- 6 physician or other person who violates subsection (a) of
- 7 this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 8 imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine not
- 9 to exceed nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00), or both.

- 11 (d) A woman upon whom an abortion is performed or
- 12 attempted in which a chemical abortion drug is used shall
- 13 not be criminally prosecuted pursuant to subsection (c) of
- 14 this section.

- 16 **Section 2.** W.S. 35-6-101(a)(vi), by creating a new
- 17 paragraph (xii) and by amending and renumbering (xii) as
- 18 (xiii) is amended to read:

20 **35-6-101.** Definitions.

22 (a) As used in the act, unless the context otherwise

1 (vi) "Pregnant" or "pregnancy" means that 2 3 condition of a woman who has a human embryo or fetus within 4 her as the result of conception; 5 6 (xii) "Chemical abortion drug" means RU-486, mifepristone, misoprostol, mifeprex, mifegyne or any 7 substantially similar generic or non-generic drug or 8 9 chemical dispensed for purposes of causing an abortion; 10  $\frac{(xii)}{(xiii)}$  "This act" means W.S. 35-6-101 11 12 through 35-6-119-35-6-120. 13 14 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2022. 15 16 (END)
