- 7 **Section 1**. W.S. 22-3-115(a)(vi), 22-5-212 and

10 22-3-115. Grounds for cancellation of registration.

12 (a) A registered elector's registration shall be

13 cancelled for any one (1) of the following reasons:

1	(vi) Upon written request of the elector <u>at any</u>
2	time except for the period for which party changes are
3	prohibited as specified in W.S. 22-5-214.

5	22-5-212. When declaration of party affiliation
6	required.

8	An elector requesting a major party ballot must shall
9	declare <u>his or change</u> party affiliation , or sign an
10	application for change of affiliation in accordance with
11	W.S. 22-5-214 before he may receive receiving a party
12	ballot. An elector may vote only the nonpartisan ballot and
13	if so, is not required to declare his party affiliation.
14	Requesting a partisan primary election ballot constitutes a
15	declaration of party affiliation. A change in declaration
16	of party affiliation shall be in accordance with the
17	requirements of W.S. 22-5-214 and shall be entered on the
18	poll list by the election judge.

22	(a) For a primary election, an elector may declare or
23	change party affiliation by completing an application

1 signed before a notarial officer or election official and

2	filing it with the county clerk not later than the first
3	day on which an application for nomination may be filed

6	(b) For a general election, an elector may declare or
7	change his party affiliation by completing an application
8	signed before a notarial officer or election official, and
9	filing it with the county clerk after the primary election
10	and not less than fourteen (14) days before the primary
11	general election or at the polls on the day of the primary
