Catch Title: Economic development programs-tribal inclusion.

**Subject:** Clarifying that the Eastern Shoshone and Northern Arapaho Tribes may

participate in specified economic development programs.

## **Summary/Major Elements:**

• This act clarifies that the Eastern Shoshone and Northern Arapaho Tribes may participate in economic development programs administered by the Wyoming Business Council. The programs are the Wyoming Business Ready Community Program, Wyoming Community Facilities Program, and Wyoming Workforce Housing Infrastructure Program.

- The act removes any requirements for separate cooperative agreements for tribes to participate in the programs.
- The act defines "cooperative tribal governing body" and specifies how it should be construed throughout Wyoming Statutes.
- The act makes conforming amendments.

## **Comments:**

• Amends major programs: Wyoming Business Ready Community Program, Wyoming Community Facilities Program, and Wyoming Workforce Housing Infrastructure Program.
