Catch Title: **Board of psychology-behavior analyst regulation.**

Subject: Board of psychology-behavior analyst regulation.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act expands the psychology practice act to permit the licensure of behavior analysts and assistant behavior analysts.
- The act provides a definition of what constitutes the practice of behavior analysis and regulates the practice of behavior analysis by the State Board of Psychology in a manner consistent with the Board's regulation of the practice of psychology under current law.
- The act modifies the composition of the State Board of Psychology by requiring that two Board members be behavior analysts, while eliminating one (1) of the two (2) public members and the member that must be a psychological practitioner.
- The act authorizes criminal history background checks for the purpose of screening all licensure applicants.
- The act also provides a grace period for persons currently practicing behavior analysis in the state, allowing continued practice during the time required by the State Board of Psychology to implement the behavior analysis licensing program created under the bill.
