14 (a) As used in this act:

15
16 (v) "Pari-mutuel event" means the events which are
17 authorized by the commission for the conduct of horse racing (to
18 include quarter horse, thoroughbred or other approved races),
19 harness racing, cutter racing, chariot racing, chuckwagon racing,
20 professional roping and rodeo events and simulcasting of dog racing
21 and the events described in this paragraph as prescribed by the
22 commission. Notwithstanding W.S. 6-7-101(a)(iv) and 11-25-203,
23 the commission may authorize and promulgate rules providing for
24 pari-mutuel wagering on events ~~that have previously occurred,~~
25 ~~utilizing an electronic system or device that affords an~~
26 ~~opportunity for the exercise of skill or judgment where the outcome~~
27 ~~is not completely controlled by chance alone~~ utilizing historic
28 pari-mutuel devices;

30 (xxi) "Historic pari-mutuel device" means an electronic
31 system or device used for pari-mutuel wagering on events that have
32 previously occurred that affords an opportunity for the exercise
33 of skill or judgment where the outcome is not completely controlled
34 by chance alone."

38 **"11-25-201. Pari-mutuel permits; fees and reports;**
39 **disposition of funds; enforcement of provisions.**

41 (a) The commission may issue pari-mutuel permits for a
42 specified period not to exceed three (3) years from the date of
43 issuance to any Wyoming county, city, incorporated town, county
44 fair board or any corporation or association which has been

1 approved by the board of county commissioners and provides a bond
2 acceptable to the commission. No permit shall be granted to any
3 city, town, county, county fair board or any corporation or
4 association except upon the express condition that it shall not,
5 by any lease, contract, understanding or arrangement of whatever
6 kind or nature, grant, assign or turn over to any person,
7 corporation or association the operation or management of the pari-
8 mutuel event permitted under this act or of the pari-mutuel system
9 of wagering or historic pari-mutuel device or in any manner permit
10 any person, corporation or association to retain any of the money
11 received for admission to the race meeting or from the operations
12 of the pari-mutuel system. The commission shall revoke the permit
13 of any permittee for any violation of the foregoing condition and
14 such acts are a violation of this act. The permit is effective
15 only for the times and at the places for which issued. In addition
16 to all other fees and charges, there shall be charged before
17 issuance of a permit a daily fee established by the commission to
18 defray expenses of enforcing this act.

19
20 (n) In permitting historic pari-mutuel events, the
21 commission shall specify the number of historic pari-mutuel
22 devices authorized to be used by a holder of a pari-mutuel permit.
23 The commission shall limit the total number of permitted historic
24 pari-mutuel devices in accordance with the following:

25
26 (i) Not more than thirty (30) historic pari-mutuel
27 devices shall be allowed in a county with a population of twenty
28 thousand (20,000) or less;

29
30 (ii) Not more than seventy-five (75) historic pari-
31 mutuel devices shall be allowed in a county with a population
32 between twenty thousand (20,000) and thirty thousand (30,000);

33
34 (iii) Not more than one hundred fifty (150) historic
35 pari-mutuel devices shall be allowed in a county with a population
36 between thirty thousand (30,000) and forty thousand (40,000);

37
38 (iv) Not more than three hundred (300) historic pari-
39 mutuel shall be allowed in a county with a population between forty
40 thousand (40,000) and eighty thousand (80,000);

41
42 (v) Not more than six hundred (600) historic pari-
43 mutuel shall be allowed in a county with a population of eighty
