2	(a) Before any territory is eligible for annexation,
3	the governing body of any city or town at a hearing as
4	provided in W.S. 15-1-405 shall find that:
5	
6	(v) If the city or town does not own or operate
7	its own electric utility, its governing body is prepared to
8	issue one (1) or more franchises as necessary to serve the
9	annexed area pursuant to W.S. 15-1-410;-and
10	
11	(vi) The annexing city or town, not less than
12	twenty (20) business days prior to <mark>before</mark> the public
13	hearing required by W.S. 15-1-405(a), has sent by certified
14	mail to all landowners and affected public utilities within
15	the territory and by first class mail to any persons owning
16	property that is adjacent to or within five hundred fifty
17	(550) feet of the territory proposed to be annexed,
18	regardless of whether the property is inside or outside the
19	corporate limits of the annexing city or town and
20	regardless of whether the city or town is exercising
21	authority under W.S. 15-3-202(b)(ii), a summary of the
22	proposed annexation report as required under subsection (c)
23	of this section, notice of the need to respond in writing

1	if the landowner approves or opposes the proposed
2	annexation unless approval is not required under paragraph
3	(vii) of this subsection, notice of the opportunity to
4	request an estimate of required infrastructure improvements
5	costs under subsection (e) of this section and notice of
6	the time, date and location of the public hearing required
7	by W.S. $15-1-405(a)$; and
8	
9	(vii) Except as otherwise provided in this
10	paragraph, not fewer than a simple majority of the
11	landowners owning a parcel of the area sought to be
12	annexed, excluding public streets, alleys and tax exempt
13	property, have approved in writing the proposed annexation
14	by responding to the notice in paragraph (vi) of this
15	subsection. Failure to respond to the notice under
16	paragraph (vi) of this subsection shall be considered an
17	approval of the proposed annexation. This paragraph shall
18	not apply if the area sought to be annexed is entirely
19	within the corporate limits of the annexing city or town.
20	

21 **Section 2.** This act applies to any proposed 22 annexation initiated on or after the effective date of this 23 act.
