1	AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; authorizing the director
2	of the department of transportation or a local authority to
3	designate a high occupancy vehicle lane; providing
4	exemptions from high occupancy vehicle lane requirements;
5	defining terms; specifying a penalty; requiring rulemaking;
6	and providing for an effective date.
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8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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10	Section 1. W.S. 31-5-238 is created to read:
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12	31-5-238. Designated high occupancy vehicle lanes;
13	exceptions; penalty.
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1 (a) The director or a local authority may designate 2 any part of a roadway or specific lane of a roadway under 3 the director's or local authority's jurisdiction as a high 4 occupancy vehicle lane, except the director or a local authority may not designate the only available lane of 5 travel in a given direction as a high occupancy vehicle 6 7 lane. 8 (b) A vehicle operating in a high occupancy vehicle 9 10 lane shall be a high occupancy vehicle except: 11 12 (i) Motorcycles, bicycles and public transportation vehicles may operate in a high occupancy 13 vehicle lane regardless of the number of occupants, subject 14 15 to the other requirements under this act; 16 17 (ii) Any vehicle making a turn from a high occupancy vehicle lane, subject to the other requirements 18 19 under this act. 20 21 (c) The department shall implement rules to provide 22 for the design, operation, maintenance and required signage for high occupancy vehicle lanes. 23

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2	(d) Any person who operates a vehicle in a high
3	occupancy vehicle lane that is not a high occupancy vehicle
4	or that is not a vehicle authorized under subsection (b) of
5	this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by:
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7	(i) For a first conviction, a fine of not more
8	than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);
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10	(ii) For a second conviction of the same offense
11	within one (1) year thereafter, a fine of not more than
12	fifty dollars (\$50.00);
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14	(iii) For a third or subsequent conviction of
15	the same offense within one (1) year after the first
16	conviction, a fine of not more than seventy-five dollars
17	(\$75.00).

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1 (B) A vehicle that: 2 3 (I) Is owned or operated by a public 4 entity; 5 6 (II) Is operated under a contract with 7 a public entity; or 8 9 (III) Is operated pursuant to a 10 license by a public entity to provide bus or school bus 11 services to the public. 12 13 (lix)(lxxii) "This act" means W.S. 31-5-101 14 through 31-5-1601.+ 15 16 31-5-106. Authorized emergency vehicles. 17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this 18 section, the driver of an authorized emergency vehicle, 19 20 when responding to an emergency call or when in pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the law or when 21 responding to but not upon returning from a fire alarm, 22 23 may:

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1 2 (iv) Disregard regulations governing direction 3 of movement, high occupancy vehicle lanes or turning in 4 specified directions. 5 6 31-5-201. Driving on right side of roadway; 7 exceptions. 8 9 (a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the roadway, except 10 as follows for any of the following: 11 12 13 (iii) Upon a roadway divided into three (3) marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable 14 15 16 17 (v) Upon a roadway designated and signposted as a high occupancy vehicle lane. 18 19 20 31-5-205. Additional limitations on driving on the 21 left; exceptions. 22 (b) Subsection (a) of this section does not apply: 23

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2	(iv) Upon a roadway designated and signposted as
3	a high occupancy vehicle lane.
