Multipurpose vehicles-disabled license plates.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; allowing a person with a
2 disability to be issued a special license plate with a
3 disabled designation for a multipurpose vehicle; specifying
4 that a distinctive symbol may be used on a disabled license
5 plate to designate vehicle type; and providing for an
6 effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-213(d)(iii)(B) and (h)(viii) is
11 amended to read:

12

13 **31-2-213. Department to supply registration**
14 **certificates, plates and stickers; removable windshield**
15 **placards.**

2 (d) As used in this section:

3

4 (iii) "Special license plate" means a license
5 plate that displays the international symbol of access:

7 (B) The plate shall consist of the arabic
8 numerals designating the county in which issued at the
9 left, followed by the bucking horse and rider emblem and a
10 distinctive combination of up to three (3) numbers and
11 letters as determined by the department, followed by the
12 international symbol of access. After the county number on
13 the left-hand end, the license plate may also contain a
14 distinctive symbol or letters, as determined by the
15 department, indicating the vehicle type. A special license
16 plate issued for a motorcycle or multipurpose vehicle shall
17 not be less than three (3) inches wide and six (6) inches
18 long and shall contain the international symbol of access
19 and appropriate identification which may be in lieu of the
20 bucking horse and rider emblem. The motorcycle and
21 multipurpose vehicle license plate may also contain a
22 distinctive symbol or letters, as determined by the
23 department, indicating the vehicle type.

2 (h) Effective January 1, 1993, any person eligible
3 for a special placard under subsection (c) of this section
4 may apply to the county treasurer for special license
5 plates for a motor vehicle owned by that person. Special
6 license plates shall not be issued to any person who is
7 eligible only for a temporary removable windshield placard
8 under subsection (g) of this section. Special plates issued
9 under this subsection are subject to the following:

11 (viii) The county treasurer shall issue a set of
12 plates for each vehicle and a special license plate for
13 each motorcycle or multipurpose vehicle registered to a
14 qualified applicant under this subsection upon payment of
15 required fees.

16

17 **Section 2.** The Wyoming department of transportation
18 shall make the motorcycle and multipurpose license plates
19 required by this act available beginning on January 1,
20 2024.

21

1 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
