## SIXTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING 2023 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; specifying that the offense of voyeurism may be committed by looking within an area where the person being viewed has a reasonable expectation of privacy; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 6-4-304(a)(intro) is amended to read:

## 6-4-304. Voyeurism; penalties.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person is guilty of а misdemeanor punishable bv imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or both, if he, without the consent of the person being viewed, commits the crime of voyeurism by looking or clandestine, surreptitious, in viewing а prying or secretive nature into or within an area where the person being viewed has a reasonable expectation of privacy, including, but not limited to:
