

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The Department of Corrections provided the following information regarding indeterminable costs: There are no current measures to allow for an accurate prediction of the number of individuals to be sentenced pursuant to the proposed legislation. Each year of incarceration, per inmate, costs the State, in current dollars, approximately \$48,817.48 including medical costs. Each year of supervision costs the State, in current dollars, approximately \$2,467.40 per person.
