1	(e) No governing body of a city or town shall enact
2	or enforce any ordinance or regulation that prohibits or
3	limits the use of or charges fees for packaging or
4	containers for consumer merchandise. As used in this
5	subsection, "consumer merchandise" means merchandise
6	offered for sale or lease, or provided with a sale or
7	lease, primarily or exclusively for personal, family or
8	household purposes or for protecting or transporting
9	merchandise, food or beverages from or at a food service or
10	retail facility.

12	18-2-101. General powers.
13	
14	(b) No county shall enact or enforce any ordinance or
15	regulation that prohibits or limits the use of or charges
16	fees for packaging or containers for consumer merchandise.
17	As used in this subsection, "consumer merchandise" means as
18	defined by W.S. 15-1-103(e).

20	Section 2. Any ordinance or regulation in effect on
21	July 1, 2023 or that is adopted thereafter by a county,
22	city or town that is in violation of this act is void and
23	unenforceable.
