A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Medical Assistance and Services Act;  
2 authorizing payment for services rendered by a licensed  
3 podiatrist under the Medical Assistance and Services Act;  
4 providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective  
5 date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 42-4-103(a) by creating a new  
10 paragraph (xxxvii) is amended to read:

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12 **42-4-103. Authorized services and supplies.**

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14 (a) Services and supplies authorized for medical  
15 assistance under this chapter include:

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(xxxvii) Podiatry services provided by a podiatrist licensed by the board of registration in podiatry.

**Section 2.** There is appropriated fifty-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$56,500.00) from the general fund and fifty-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$56,500.00) from federal funds to the department of health for the purpose of including podiatry services as services authorized for medical assistance under W.S. 42-4-103. This appropriation is for the period beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024. This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation on June 30, 2024 shall revert as provided by law. It is the intent of the legislature that an appropriation to fund the podiatry services authorized by this act be included in the department of health's standard budget request for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.

1           **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
