2 (v) Based upon ADM computations and identified 3 school configurations within each district pursuant to 4 paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute the foundation program amount for each district as prescribed by the 5 education resource block grant model adopted by the Wyoming 6 legislature as defined under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xiv), as 7 contained within the spreadsheets and accompanying reports 8 9 referenced under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xvii). The following 10 criteria shall be used by the state superintendent in the 11 administration of the education resource block grant model:

Salaries for all school and district 13 (C) 14 level staffing categories, including teachers, principals and assistant principals, central office administrators, 15 16 secretarial and clerical staff, operations and maintenance 17 staff and aides and media technicians, shall be based upon levels calibrated 18 statewide salary average under 19 "Attachment A" for each staffing category, adjusted under 20 subsection (o) of this section, including the experience, 21 education and responsibility level as appropriate and as computed for each staffing category. The statewide average 22 23 for each staffing category shall be adjusted for each

1 district based upon the district experience, education and 2 responsibility level relative to the statewide average for 3 category. District experience, education 4 responsibility level by appropriate staffing category shall be updated each year such that district adjustments reflect 5 the prior school year staffing information. The district 6 adjusted average salary for each staffing category shall be 7 8 further adjusted for regional cost differences as measured 9 by the greater of the hedonic wage index or the Wyoming 10 cost-of-living index computed by the division of economic 11 analysis, department of administration and information, 12 with a minimum of one hundred (100) index value, 13 prescribed by the education resource block grant model. For purposes of the education resource block grant model, the 14 15 version of the Wyoming cost-of-living index used by the 16 division shall be based upon the unrecalibrated housing 17 cost index weights unless otherwise determined by the legislature based upon recommendation of the 18 joint 19 education interim committee. In addition, the version of 20 Wyoming cost-of-living index applied under this 21 subparagraph for any school year shall be the greater of the average of the six (6) consecutive semi-annual index 22 23 reports completed by January 1 of the immediately preceding
