

## SENATE FILE NO. SF0056

Prohibiting travel across private land for hunting purposes.

Sponsored by: Joint Judiciary Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; expanding the prohibition  
2 for entering private property without permission for  
3 hunting purposes to also prohibit traveling through the  
4 private property; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-3-305(b) is amended to read:

9

10 **23-3-305. Hunting from highway; entering or traveling**  
11 **through private property without permission; penalty;**  
12 **hunting at night without permission prohibited.**

14 (b) No person shall enter upon, travel through or  
15 return across the private property of any person to take

1 wildlife, hunt, fish, collect antlers or horns, or trap  
2 without the permission of the owner or person in charge of  
3 the property. Violation of this subsection constitutes a  
4 low misdemeanor punishable as provided in W.S.  
5 23-6-202(a)(v). For purposes of this subsection "travel  
6 through or return across" requires physically touching or  
7 driving on the surface of the private property.

8

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
