

Rules of the House of Representatives 6-2 is amended to read:

6-2 Order of General File.

(a) Bills on the general file shall be considered in the following order: first, "Do Pass" bills; second, "Without Recommendation" bills; and third, "Do Not Pass" bills.

(b) The Majority Floor Leader shall specify the order in which bills on the general file shall be considered in committee of the whole pursuant to subsection (a) of this section. A motion to amend the order of consideration of bills on general file during the committee of the whole made by a member who is not the majority floor leader is a special order and shall require:

(i) A two-thirds vote of the elected members to sustain if the special order states that the bill shall be considered in committee of the whole on the same legislative day that the special order is made or if the special order is made on the last calendared day for committee of the whole in the House for either house bills or senate files as applicable; or

(ii) A majority vote of the members present to sustain if the special order specifies that the bill shall be considered in committee of the whole on the succeeding or later legislative day. SOMMERS, CHAIRMAN
