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5 9-14-303. Prohibiting the use of state resources for

6 enforcement of federal regulations regarding federal land

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9 Upon a determination by the governor, with advice 10 from the attorney general, that an executive order, final rule or regulation of the federal government does not 11 12 comply with federal laws regarding federal land management 13 and upon providing notice, this state and all political subdivisions of this state shall not use any personnel, 14 15 funds appropriated by the legislature or any other source 16 of funds that originate within the state of Wyoming to 17 enforce or administer that federal executive order, final rule or regulation. The governor shall not revoke a valid 18 19 primacy agreement with a federal agency over the regulation 20 and enforcement of a federal law or program until a court 21 of competent jurisdiction determines the federal executive order, final rule or regulation is unlawful. 22

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1 (b) Nothing in this act shall limit or restrict a public officer, as defined by W.S. 6-5-101(a)(v), from 2 3 providing assistance to federal authorities for purposes 4 not specifically identified in subsection (a) of this section. Nothing in this act shall be construed to prohibit 5 any governmental entity from accepting federal funds for 6 7 law enforcement purposes.

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9 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
