AN ACT relating to public health and safety; requiring the 1 2 licensure of surgical abortion facilities as specified; 3 requiring licensed physicians to perform abortions after an ultrasound; providing criminal penalties for violations; 4 specifying civil liability for damages resulting from 5 abortions; providing definitions; making conforming 6 7 amendments; specifying applicability; requiring rulemaking; 8 and providing for an effective date. 9

12 **Section 1**. W.S. 35-6-201 through 35-6-205 are created

3	35-6-201. Definitions.
4	
5	(a) As used in this article:
6	
7	(i) "Abortion" means the act of using or
8	prescribing any instrument, medicine, drug or any other
9	substance, device or means with the intent to terminate the
10	clinically diagnosable pregnancy of a woman, including the
11	elimination of one (1) or more unborn babies in a
12	multifetal pregnancy, with knowledge that the termination
13	by those means will, with reasonable likelihood, cause the
14	death of the unborn baby. "Abortion" shall not include any
15	use, prescription or means specified in this paragraph if
16	the use, prescription or means are done with the intent to:
17	
18	(A) Save the life or preserve the health of
19	the unborn baby;
20	
21	(B) Remove a dead unborn baby caused by
22	spontaneous abortion or intrauterine fetal demise;

1	(C) Treat a woman for an ectopic pregnancy;
2	or
3	
4	(D) Provide treatment for a pregnant woman
5	when a medical procedure or treatment is necessary, based
6	on reasonable medical judgment, to save or preserve the
7	life of the pregnant woman.
8	
9	(ii) "Hospital" means those institutions
10	licensed by the Wyoming department of health as hospitals;
11	
12	(iii) "Physician" means any person licensed to
13	practice medicine in this state;
14	
15	(iv) "Pregnancy" or "pregnant" means the human
16	female reproductive condition of having a living unborn
17	baby or human being within a human female's body throughout
18	the entire embryonic and fetal stages of the unborn human
19	being from fertilization to full gestation and childbirth;
20	
21	(v) "Reasonable medical judgment" means a
22	medical judgment that would be made or a medical action
23	that would be undertaken by a reasonably prudent, qualified

- 1 physician who is knowledgeable about the case and the
- 2 treatment possibilities with respect to the medical
- 3 conditions involved;

- 5 (vi) "Surgical abortion" means an induced
- 6 abortion performed or attempted through use of a machine,
- 7 medical device, surgical instrument or surgical tool, or
- 8 any combination thereof, to terminate the clinically
- 9 diagnosable pregnancy of a woman with knowledge and the
- 10 intent that the termination by those means will cause, with
- 11 reasonable likelihood, the death of the unborn child;

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- 13 (vii) "Surgical abortion facility" means any
- 14 facility, other than a hospital, that provides a surgical
- 15 abortion to a woman and performs not less than three (3)
- 16 first-trimester surgical abortions in any one (1) month or
- 17 not less than one (1) second-trimester or third-trimester
- 18 surgical abortion in any one (1) year.

- 20 35-6-202. Surgical abortion facilities; licensure

1	(a) Each surgical abortion facility in Wyoming shall
2	be licensed as an ambulatory surgical center in accordance
3	with W.S. $35-2-901$ through $35-2-914$ and the rules of the
4	department of health. Each surgical abortion facility
5	performing surgical abortions shall have a separate
6	license.
7	
8	(b) No surgical abortion facility shall provide
9	surgical abortions to any pregnant woman without first
10	being licensed as an ambulatory surgical center.
11	
12	(c) Each surgical abortion facility shall comply with
13	all rules of the department of health concerning the
14	operation and regulation of ambulatory surgical centers. No
15	license issued to a surgical abortion facility shall be
16	transferable or assignable to any other person or facility.
17	
18	(d) Each licensed physician performing at least one
19	(1) surgical abortion at a surgical abortion facility
20	shall:
21	
22	(i) Report each surgical abortion to the
23	department of health and shall attest in the report that

1	the physician is licensed and in good standing with the
2	state board of medicine;
3	
4	(ii) Submit documentation in a form and
5	frequency required by the department of health that
6	demonstrates that the licensed physician has admitting
7	privileges at a hospital located not more than ten (10)
8	miles from the abortion facility where the licensed
9	physician is performing or will perform surgical abortions.

L1	(e) Any person who violates this section shall be
L2	guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed
L3	one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Each calendar day in
L 4	which a violation of this section occurs or continues is a
L5	separate offense.

L8	requirements; rulemaking.

20	(a) Any surgical abortion performed at a surgical

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abortion facility in the state shall only be performed by a

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physician licensed in the state of Wyoming.

1	(b)	Any	person	who	performs	in	the	state	any	surgio	cal
2	abortion	at a	a surgi	cal	abortion	fac	cilit	y in	viol	ation	of

3 subsection (a) of this section is guilty of a felony

4 punishable by imprisonment for not less than one (1) year

5 nor more than fourteen (14) years.

7 (c) No person shall perform a surgical abortion at a 8 surgical abortion facility in Wyoming who is not a licensed 9 physician with admitting privileges at a hospital located 10 not more than ten (10) miles from the abortion facility

where the surgical abortion is performed.

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(d) Any person who violates subsection (c) of this section or if a pharmacist or physician violates W.S. 35-6-205 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000,00). For purposes of this subsection, each surgical abortion at a surgical abortion facility shall constitute a separate offense of subsection (c) of this section.

21 (e) The department of health shall promulgate rules 22 necessary to regulate surgical abortion facilities as

1	ambulatory surgical centers under W.S. 35-2-901 through
2	35-2-914, provided that the rules:
3	
4	(i) Applicable to surgical abortion facilities
5	are not less stringent than those rules applicable to
6	ambulatory surgical centers;
7	
8	(ii) Provide for the physical inspection of
9	surgical abortion facilities by the department of health
10	every three (3) years.
11	
12	35-6-204. Applicability; effect.
13	
14	If any provision of this article conflicts with the Life is
15	a Human Right Act or W.S. 35-6-139, the provisions of the
16	Life is a Human Right Act and W.S. 35-6-139 shall control
17	over this article to the extent that the Life is a Human
18	Right Act and W.S. 35-6-139 are enforceable.
19	
20	35-6-205. Abortion facilities; licensure requirements
21	verification; prohibitions; penalties.

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1	Not less than forty-eight (48) hours before a pregnant
2	woman procures the drugs or substances for a chemical
3	abortion, before a physician or pharmacist dispenses the
4	drugs or substances necessary for a chemical abortion or
5	before a pregnant woman undergoes a surgical abortion, the
6	physician or pharmacist shall ensure that the pregnant
7	woman receives an ultrasound in order to determine the
8	gestational age of the unborn child, to determine the
9	location of the pregnancy, to verify a viable intrauterine
10	pregnancy and to provide the pregnant woman the opportunity
11	to view the active ultrasound of the unborn child and hear
12	the heartbeat of the unborn child if the heartbeat is
13	audible. The provider of the ultrasound shall provide the
14	pregnant woman with a document that specifies the date,
15	time and place of the ultrasound.

17	Section 2. W.S. 35-2-901(a)(ii) is amended to read:

19	35-2-901. Definitions; applicability of provisions.
20	
21	(a) As used in this act:
22	

1	(ii) "Ambulatory surgical center" means a
2	facility which provides surgical treatment to patients not
3	requiring hospitalization and is not part of a hospital or
4	offices of private physicians, dentists or podiatrists.
5	"Ambulatory surgical center" shall include any surgical
6	abortion facility as defined by W.S. 35-6-201(a)(vii);
7	
8	Section 3.
9	
LO	(a) Nothing in this act shall be construed as
L1	creating an individual right to abortion.
L2	
L3	(b) It is the intent of the legislature that this act
L4	shall not be construed as holding abortion as lawful in the
L5	state pending a decision from a court of competent
L6	jurisdiction on the current state of the law.
L7	
L8	(c) It is the intent of the legislature that this act
L9	shall not recognize or define abortion as a health care
20	decision under Article 1, section 38 of the Wyoming
21	Constitution.

1 Section 4. The department of health shall promulgate

2 all rules necessary to implement this act.

3

4 **Section 5.** This act is effective immediately upon

5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

7 Constitution.
