State employee leave for volunteer fire or volunteer EMS.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;  
2 providing state employees leave to serve as volunteer  
3 emergency response personnel; requiring rulemaking; and  
4 providing for effective dates.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-107 is created to read:

9

10 **9-3-107. Leave for volunteer emergency response**  
11 **personnel.**

13 Every state officer and employee shall receive up to  
14 twenty-four (24) hours of leave with pay during each  
15 calendar year to use when the state officer or employee is

1 absent from work due to service as a rostered volunteer  
2 with a volunteer fire department, licensed ambulance  
3 service or county search and rescue organization in the  
4 state of Wyoming.

6 **Section 2.** The department of administration and  
7 information shall promulgate all rules necessary to  
8 implement this act.

10 **Section 3.**

12 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of  
13 this section, this act is effective July 1, 2024.

14

15 (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective  
16 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a  
17 bill to become a law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of  
18 the Wyoming Constitution.
