- 16 6-2-316(a)(i) and (iv), 6-2-705, 6-4-303(b)(iv) or W.S.

1 6-4-304(b) if the victim was a minor, 18 U.S.C. §§ 2252B, 2252C, 2424 and 2425, an offense in another jurisdiction 2 3 containing the same or similar elements, or arising out of 4 the same or similar facts or circumstances as a criminal offense specified in this subsection or an attempt or 5 conspiracy to commit any of the offenses specified in this 6 subsection, the division shall annually verify the accuracy 7 8 of the offender's registered address, and the offender shall annually report, in person, his current address to 9 10 the sheriff in the county in which the offender resides, 11 during the period in which he is required to register. 12 During the annual in-person verification, the sheriff shall 13 photograph the offender. Confirmation of the in-person verification required under this subsection, along with the 14 photograph of the offender, shall be transmitted by the 15 16 sheriff to the division within three (3) working days. 17 person under this subsection who has not established a residence or is transient, and who is reporting to the 18 sheriff as required under subsection (e) of this section, 19 20 shall be deemed in compliance with the address verification 21 requirements of this section.

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1 (h) For an offender convicted of a violation of W.S. 2 6-2-304(a)(iii) if the victim was at least fourteen (14) 3 years of age, W.S. 6-2-314(a)(ii) and (iii), 6-2-315(a)(i)4 and (iii), W.S. 6-2-315(a)(iv) if the victim was thirteen 5 (13)through fifteen (15)years of age, W.S. 6 6-2-316(a)(ii), 6-2-317(a)(i) and (ii) or 6-2-318, W.S. 6-2-706, W.S. 6-4-102 if the person solicited was a minor, 7 8 W.S. 6-4-103 if the person enticed or compelled was a minor, W.S. 6-4-302(a)(i) if the offense involves the use 9 10 of a minor in a sexual performance or W.S. 6-4-303(b)(i)through (iii), 18 U.S.C. § 2251, an offense in another 11 12 jurisdiction containing the same or similar elements, or 13 arising out of the same or similar facts or circumstances as a criminal offense specified in this subsection, an 14 15 attempt or conspiracy to commit any of the offenses 16 specified in this subsection, or any offense enumerated in 17 subsection (g) of this section if the offender 18 previously convicted of offense any enumerated in 19 subsection (g) of this section, the division shall verify 20 the accuracy of the offender's registered address, and the 21 offender shall report, in person, his current address to the sheriff in the county in which the offender resides, 22 every six (6) months after the date of the initial release 23

- 19 the victim was less than thirteen (13) years of age, W.S.
- 20 $\frac{6-2-316(a)(ii)}{and}$ and $\frac{(iii)}{6-2-316(a)(iii)}$, $\frac{6-2-702}{and}$ or
- 21 6-2-703, 6-4-402, 18 U.S.C. § 2245, or an offense in
- 22 another jurisdiction containing the same or similar
- 23 elements, or arising out of the same or similar facts or

1 circumstances as a criminal offense specified in this 2 subsection, an attempt or conspiracy to commit any of the 3 offenses specified in this subsection, any offense 4 enumerated in subsection (h) of this section if 5 offender was previously convicted of any offense enumerated in subsection (g) of this section or any offense enumerated 6 in subsection (g) or (h) of this section if the offender 7 8 was previously convicted of any offense enumerated in subsection (h) of this section, the division shall verify 9 10 the accuracy of the offender's registered address, and the 11 offender shall report, in person, his current address to 12 the sheriff in the county in which the offender resides every three (3) months after the date of the initial 13 release or commencement of parole. If the offender's 14 appearance has changed substantially, and in any case at 15 16 least annually, the sheriff shall photograph the offender. 17 Confirmation of the in-person verification required by this subsection, and any new photographs of the offender, shall 18 19 be transmitted by the sheriff to the division within three 20 (3) working days. Any person under this subsection who has 21 not established a residence or is transient, and who is reporting to the sheriff as required under subsection (e) 22

1 of this section, shall be deemed in compliance with the

2 address verification requirements of this section.
